Dear Voting Members:

Attached you will find:

- (1) The Rules Committee's Unanimous Report and recommended Constitutional Changes from the Rules Committee; and
- (2) The Committee's Unanimous comments and review of the proposals submitted by a Voting Member.

In connection with the Bylaws, we are opening the comment period on these provisions today, February 2, 2018. The comment period will close on February 16, 2018.

Further, please note that the attached proposal from the Rules Committee involves a shift of many provisions out of the Constitution, and into Statewide Standing Rules, which will be adopted, debated, and enacted by the Membership. Importantly, we have noted that violation of these rules does not affect candidate nomination, in an effort to ensure that errors of volunteers do not affect our candidates.

In an effort to facilitate timely review of these changes, the Rules Committee will have a draft proposal for these Standing Rules submitted for your consideration not later than February 9, 2018, which will be posted on the party's website.

Any member should likewise feel free to submit their own proposals on standing rules, or to comment on ours, not later than February 16, 2018.

The final work of the Rules Committee will be concluded by February 24, 2018, and posted to the party's website.
